2. Move to Investigasi (Investigate): ask the 5W+H questions — Who, What, Why, Where, When, How.
3. Progress to Ajaran/Artinya (Acquired/Insight) and then Implementasi (Implement).
4. Use AI to generate four types of questions: Observation, Discussion, Reflection, and Application — all in one prompt.

C. AI Learning Tips

1. Treat AI as a conversational partner, not a one-way information machine.

2. Move from information → understanding → experience → wisdom progressively.
